Coverage window used here: Jan 2025 to 19 Apr 2026. This sheet is intentionally honest: some entries are newly launched campaigns / digital initiatives / programme expansions, not only brand-new umbrella schemes.

How to use this sheet

- Best for last-week revision: focus on exact date, target population, duration, age cutoff, free vs covered service, and named portal / app / framework.
- For exam purposes, dates like 05 Apr 2025, 17 Sep 2025, 18 Nov 2025, 17 Feb 2026, 28 Feb 2026 and 24 Mar 2026 are the anchors.
- If a future exam asks 'recent health schemes / launches / national campaigns', these are the ones most worth remembering from the official 2025-26 window.

1	Delhi joins AB PM-JAY; operational rollout of AVVY in Delhi	05 Apr 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Delhi became the 35th State/UT to implement Ayushman Bharat PM-JAY. - Card distribution for the scheme in Delhi was stated to start from 10 Apr 2025. - Central cover remains Rs. 5 lakh per beneficiary family per year. - Delhi government announced an additional top-up of Rs. 5 lakh. - All senior citizens aged 70 years and above, irrespective of socio-economic status, were stated to be covered under Ayushman Vay Vandana Yojana (AVVY). - Pre-existing diseases were stated to be covered from day one.
2	Swasth Nari, Sashakt Parivar Abhiyaan	17 Sep 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Campaign dates: 17 Sep 2025 to 02 Oct 2025. - Jointly led by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Ministry of Women & Child Development. - More than 10 lakh health camps were planned across the country. - Held at Ayushman Arogya Mandirs, CHCs, District Hospitals and other government health facilities. - Focus: women-centric preventive, promotive and curative services.
3	National Action Plan on Antimicrobial Resistance 2.0	18 Nov 2025	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NAP-AMR 2.0 period: 2025-2029. - Official messaging emphasized AMR as a major public-health concern. - Action areas highlighted include awareness, education and training, laboratory capacity and infection prevention / control. - One Health approach is emphasized in the official documents.

5	SAHI and BODH initiatives	17 Feb 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Launched during the India AI Impact Summit 2026. - SAHI = Strategy for Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare for India. - BODH = Benchmarking Open Data Platform for Health AI. - Official framing: safe, ethical, transparent and evidence-based AI deployment in healthcare.
6	Nationwide HPV Vaccination Programme	28 Feb 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Targets approximately 1.15 crore girls aged 14 years every year. - Vaccine to be provided free of cost at designated government health facilities. - Mission-mode special campaign for 3 months; thereafter available on routine immunization days. - Vaccination stated to be voluntary with informed consent from parents/guardians.
7	Intensified 100-Day TB Mukht Bharat Campaign	24 Mar 2026	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Campaign announced as a focused and intensified 100-day push. - Coverage: 1.58 lakh villages and urban wards. - Micro-planned targeted interventions emphasized. - Official focus on vulnerable populations such as urban poor, tribal communities and migrants. - TB Mukht Bharat App launched; 'Khushi' described as an AI-enabled multilingual chatbot.

- NAP-AMR 2.0 = 2025-2029.
- AAM snapshot = 1,81,873 operational as on 30 Nov 2025; 12 services + teleconsultation.
- SAHI = Strategy for Artificial Intelligence in Healthcare for India.
- BODH = Benchmarking Open Data Platform for Health AI.
- Nationwide HPV campaign = 28 Feb 2026; approx 1.15 crore girls aged 14; free at government facilities; 3-month mission mode.
